



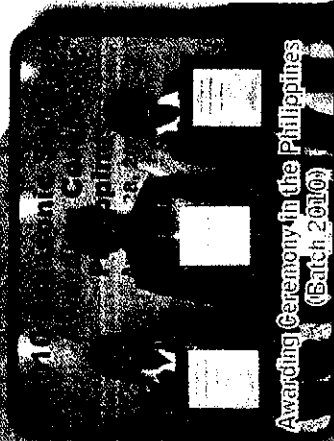
SUBJECT: Invitation to the 2011 Panasonic Scholarship Program
